There is also an article "Popular Protest and Social Crime: The Evidence of Criminal Gangs in Rural Southern England 1790—1860" by Roger Wells and published in a journal *Southern History* 13, 1991

More work is being undertaken to attempt to unravel this violent and difficult period of policing in the rural areas of Surrey, Kent and Sussex.
